R.D.CONGO

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been in the Congo since 1969. Presently there are 4 Communities and 20 Sisters.



R.D.Congo 1: Sponsorship and Literacy programmes for women, also sewing.

One of the purposes of the Project is:

To teach adolescents and young women to cut and to sew so that they may have a means of sustenance.

Where the Project takes place: Kinshasa. Comuna de Masina I.

Number of beneficiaries: 128 adolescents and young women.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **9.000,-€.**

R.D.Congo 2: Name of the Project: Aymer Kindergarten.

One of the purposes of the Project is:

To promote the welfare of children in a favourable educational environment.

Where the Project takes place: Nzo ya Ngemba.

Number of beneficiaries: 196 children aged 4 to 5, their families and 3 teachers.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **9.000,-€.**

R.D.Congo 3: Help given to a Primary School.

One of the purposes of the Project is:

To expand and enhance schooling, in order to prepare them for their future.

Where the Project takes place: Kinshasa. Comuna Masina I.

Number of beneficiaries: 680 students and 16 teachers.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **15.000 -€.**

R.D.Congo 4: Construction of the Sacred Hearts Secondary School.

One of the purposes of the project is:

To prepare schoolchildren for access to the University and to

Where the Project takes place: Kinshasa. Comuna Masina I.

Number of beneficiaries: 180 adolescents, 20 teachers and new administrative and service personnel.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **50.000,-€.**

R.D.Congo 5: Special Education.

One of the purposes of the Project is:

To help students to be independent in basic things, teaching them how to dress, to button their clothes and their personal hygiene, how to comb their hair, to brush their teeth, to wash themselves.

here the Project takes place: Kinshasa. Comuna Masina I.

Number of beneficiaries: 29 children and young people with physical disabilities.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **5.000,-€**



R.D. Congo 6: To improve the infrastructure in order to care for people with disabilities.

One of the purposes of the Project is:

To assist people with disabilities and physical limitations and for the healing of a limbs.

Where the Project takes place: : Kinshasa. Comuna Masina I.

Number of beneficiaries: : 150 people, children, young people and adults.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **12.000,-€.**



ECUADOR

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been in Ecuador since 1862.

Presently there are 12 Communities and 61 Sisters.

Welcome and help for refugees, migrants and displaced persons.

One of the purposes of the Project is: To welcome women of legal age with their children in a situation of human mobility where they are compelled to relocate, providing them with school tutoring and recreational, cultural and health activities.

Where the Project takes place: Barrio Las Casas de Quito.

Number of beneficiaries: 425 personas.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **19.369.12€.**



PHILIPPINES

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been present in the Philippines since 1991. Presently there are 3 Communities and 12 Sisters.



Philippines: Name of the Project: Nutrition and the celebration of Life.

One of the purposes of the Project is :

To care for children malnourished since birth to enable a subsequent satisfactory development.

Where the Project takes place: Bagong Silang (Manila).

Number of beneficiaries: 250 children, 200 mothers and 50 pregnant women.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **4.267.02€.**

INDIA

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been in India since 1987. There are 2 Communities and 9 Sisters.



India: Human and Christian development for Young people.

One of the purposes of the Project is:

To offer a secure family environment for young people and to accompany their process as a woman and as a student.

Where the Project takes Place: Bhubaneswar, Orissa State, District of Khurda, in India.

Number of beneficiaries: 30 young people from rural zones.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **20,000-€.**

MEXICO

The Congregation has been in Mexico since 1986. Presently there is 1 Community and 6 Sisters.



Name of the Project: Care of the migrants in the House of Welcome.

One of the purposes of the Project is:

To have adequate and available space to welcome migrants who are trying to go to or to return from the United States in a train called "The Beast".

Where the Project takes place: Bojay, Atitalaquia.

Number of beneficiaries: 200 people each month.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **400-€.**

MOZAMBIQUE

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been in Mozambique since 1995. There are 2 Communities and 13 Sisters.

Mozambique 1: Sacred Hearts Infant Centre.

One of the purposes of the Project is:

To manage a dining room to provide the children with a meal a day, and a time of rest with the nap after eating. Also to take care of their health and that of their parents.

Where the Project takes place: Boane.



Number of beneficiaries: 116 children and their parents.
 Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **10.000€.**

Mozambique 2: Sponsorship and care in the house "Lar Mamana wa Kurula", for girls and young orphans with HIV / AIDS, providing them with home, family and training, a playground and a computer room.



One of the purposes of the Project is:
 To welcome, care for and support orphaned children affected by AIDS, maintaining the Home as a place of welcome and training.
 Where the Project takes place: Boane.
 Number of beneficiaies: 40 boarers and 60 day pupils.
 Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **15.000,-€.**

PERÚ

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been present in Peru since 1848. There are 5 Communities and 40 Sisters.



Development options for children and adolescents.

One of the purposes of the Project is:
 To set up a musical group, symphonic band that motivates development and artistic interest.
 Where the Project takes place: Arequipa (Perú).
 Number of beneficiaries: 330 adolescents aged from 9 to 16.
 Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: **20.869.12€.**

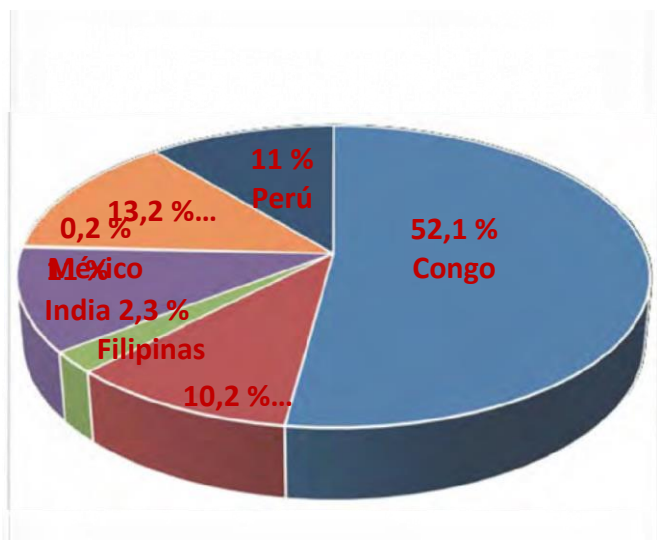
