Presence of the Congregation since 1965. Currently 7 Sisters in 1 Community.

#### Rehabilitation and social reinsertion of drug addicts.

Objective: Attention to the drug addict and his family and that this has a positive impact on the life of the family nucleus and on society. The Project is carried out in Belo Horizonte, Brazil.

The number of beneficiaries is 360 people.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 8.197,-€.

#### **COLOMBIA**

Presence of the Congregation since 1945. Currently 23 Sisters in 4 Communities.

### Promotion and human formation of families, young people and children

Objective: To accompany and support children in their learning process, to promote and accompany young people in the creation of their life project, and to accompany families who are in a situation of vulnerability, to establish good relations with themselves and with the environment through reconciliation and forgiveness.

The Project is carried out in Pereira-Risaralda.

The number of beneficiaries 300 people.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 4.000,-€

Presence of the Congregation since 1969. Currently 18 Sisters in 4 Communities..

Sponsorship and literacy of women, and sewing.

Objective: To contribute to the formation of young women and to teach teenagers and young women to cut and sew so that they feel valued and it serve them as means of sustenance,

Place where the Project is carried out: Kinshasa. Commune of Masina I.

Number of beneficiaries: 86 teenagers and young women.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 4.000,-€.

#### R.D.Congo 2: Aid to the Primary School.

Objective: To increase attention and schooling in order to prepare them for their future, offering the possibility of being able to follow their formation in the following courses later.

Place where the Project is carried out: Kinshasa. Commune Masina I.

Number of beneficiaries: 900 students and 16 teachers.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 6.557,-€

### R.D.Congo 3: Complete Construction of Sacred Hearts Secondary School, and Equipment to start operations.

Objective: To prepare schoolchildren for access to the University and for them to be builders of a new African society.

Place where the Project is carried out: Kinshasa. Commune Masina I. Number of beneficiaries: 250 adolescents and 18 teachers with new administrative and service staff.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 50.000,-€.

## R.D.Congo 4: To improve the infrastructure for the care of people with disabilities.

Objective: To attend disabled people, and people with physical limitations, for the recovery of a member of their body. Apparatus and other materials for massage exercises

Place where the Project is carried out: Kinshasa. Commune Masina I. Number of beneficiaries: 150 people, children, young people and adults.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 7.000,-€.

## R.D.Congo 5: Special education for the deaf and mentally handicapped.

Objective: To make students autonomous in basic things, to teach them how to dress, put on their shoes, buckle up and advance in their personal hygiene, comb their hair, brush their teeth, wash themselves, in order to try their personal autonomy.

Place where the Project is carried out: Kinshasa. Commune Masina I. Number of beneficiaries: 30 children and young people with physical disabilities and their parents trained.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 4.000,-€.

#### Congo 6: Aymer Kindergarten.

Objective: To promote the well-being of children from a favourable educational environment, and to facilitate their subsequent integration into the following courses of the School.

Place where the Project is carried out: Nzo ya Ngemba.

Number of beneficiaries: 150 children from 4 to 5 years old, their

families and teachers.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 4.918,-€.

#### **ECUADOR**

Presence of the Congregation since 1862. Currently 64 Sisters in 13 Communities.

#### **Cut, Sew and Create Workshop.**

Objective: To implement the workshop with updated machinery to train rural women of low economic resources.

Location of the Project: Piñas, Province of El Oro, Ecuador.

Number of beneficiaries: 90 mothers, housewives, and 20 young

people.

Amount given by the Foundation: 18.000,-€

#### **PHILIPPINES**

Presence of the Congregation since 1991. Currently 13 Sisters in 3 Communities.

#### Philippines 1: Scholarships for university students.

Objective: That young students may go to the University to finish their studies, and that they may improve their situation, their knowledge, and their promotion, and that they may contribute to the development of the country.

Place where the Project is carried out: Bagong Silang. Manila.

Number of beneficiaries: 18 students.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 17.000,-€.

#### Philippines 2: Nutrition project, celebration of life.

Objective: To attend malnourished children from their gestation, to help reduce mortality, so that their later development is satisfactory, and to accompany families and pregnant mothers.

Place where the Project is carried out: Bagong Silang. Manila.

Number of beneficiaries: 250 children, 200 mothers and 50 pregnant women.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 3.000,-€.

#### Philippines 3: Means of transport for the Social Centre.

Objective: To generate a basic service with a means of transport to be able to access a better quality of life, and to be able to transfer sick people, pregnant women, and people with different capacities.

Place where the Project is carried out: Bagong Silang. Manila.

Number of beneficiaries: 350 people.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: Montant remis par la

#### **INDIA**

Presence of the Congregation since 1987. Currently 8 Sisters in 2 Communities.

#### India 1: Empowerment of women and girls.

Objective: To provide a peaceful space for studies, giving importance to the education of poor children, and to give special attention to weak students, so that they can improve the results of their studies.

Place where the Project is carried out: Calcutta. India

Number of beneficiaries: 35 boys and girls.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 4.000,-€.

#### India 2: Human and Christian formation of young people.

Objective: To offer a safe and familiar place to young women and girls in need, to accompany their process as women and students, and that they receive a quality education for their future.

Place where the Project is carried out: Bhuvaneswar, Orissa State,

Khurda District. India.

Number of beneficiaries: 30 rural youth.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 20.000,-€.

#### **MEXICO**

Presence of the Congregation since 1986. Currently 5 Sisters in 1 Community.

#### Attention and welcome to migrants.

Objective: To dignify the transit of migrants as they pass through Bojay, giving support to their basic needs, through a dignified, equal and close treatment, in collaboration with other Organisms. To offer them a shelter and guarantee that human rights are respected. Place where the Project is carried out: Bojay, Atitalaquia. Mexico Number of beneficiaries: 400 people each month.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 15.000,-€.

#### **MOZAMBIQUE**

Presence of the Congregation since 1995. Currently 11 Sisters in 2 Communities.

#### Mozambique 1: Lar Mamana Wa Kurula.

Objective: To welcome, support and educate orphan girls, victims, they and their mothers of HIV, with an integral formation that will allow them the psychosocial and professional development that will enable them to face their future with autonomy. Provide them with a place to live, and connect them with their families.

Place where the Project is carried out: Boane. Mozambique

Number of beneficiaries: 40 girls.

Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: 26.000,-€


#### **Mozambique 2: Sacred Hearts Children's Centre.**

Objective: Children's playground, conservation and improvement of facilities, classrooms for classes, and management of a canteen to provide children with one meal a day, and a time to rest with a nap after eating, as well as to attend sanitarily to them and their parents. Place where the Project is carried out: Boane. Mozambique Number of beneficiaries: 125 children and their parents. Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 16.000,-€.
