### BRAZIL

The Congregation has been present since 1965. To date there are 7 Sisters in 1 Community.

## **R.D. CONGO**

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been in the Congo since 1969. Presently there are 4 Communities and 17 Sisters.







#### BRAZIL: Rehabilitation and social reintegration of drug addicts

Objective: Attention to the drug addict and his/her family and that this has a positive impact on the life of the family nucleus and on society.

The Project is carried out in Belo Horizonte, Brazil. The number of beneficiaries is 360 people. Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €2,084.92

# R.D.Congo 1: Sponsorship and Literacy programmes for women, also sewing.

Objective: To contribute to the training of young women and to teach teenage girls and young women how to cut and sew so that they feel valued and can provide for their livelihoods, Project location: Kinshasa Commune of Masina I. Number of beneficiaries: 102 adolescents and young women. Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €4.000

#### R.D.Congo 2: Aymer Kindergarten.

Objective: To promote the well-being of children in a favourable educational environment, and to facilitate their subsequent integration into following courses in School. Place where the Project is carried out: Nzo ya Ngemba. Number of beneficiaries: 60 children from 4 to 5 years old, their families and teachers.

Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €1,500

#### R.D.Congo 3: Sacred Hearts School (Primary and Secondary).

Objective: To ensure care and schooling, in order to prepare children for their future, offering the possibility of being able to continue their education at University level.







Place where the Project is carried out: Kinshasa. Comuna Masina I. Number of those who benefit: 1,200 alumn@s 16 teachers. Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €65,000

# R.D.Congo 4: Special education for the deaf, dumb and mentally handicapped

Objective: To help the students have autonomy in basic things, to teach them to dress, to wear shoes, to fasten and advance in their personal hygiene, to comb their hair, to brush their teeth, to wash themselves, for their personal autonomy.

Place where the Project is carried out: Kinshasa. Commune Masina I.

Number of beneficiaries: 31 children and young people with physical disabilities and training for their parents, 3 teachers, (social educators).

Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €5,000

# R.D.Congo 5: Kinesitherapy. Improve the infrastructure for the care of people with physical disabilities.

Objective: To have enough space and be well equipped, to attend to disabled people, and those with physical limitations, for the recovery of some parts of their body. Equipment and other materials for massage exercises Project location: Kinshasa. Commune Masina I. Number of beneficiaries: 150 people, children, young people and adults.

Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €9,000

### **ECUADOR**

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been in Ecuador since 1862. Presently there are 13 Communities and 57 Sisters.

#### Human and social development.

Objective: To offer alternatives for personal and family improvement, to cultivate the capacity to carry out undertakings, personal integration and teamwork. Project location: Salinas, Province of Santa Elena, Ecuador Number of beneficiaries: 450 in three workshops. Amount contributed by the Aymer Fundation: €15,057.27



#### **PHILIPPINES**

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been present in the Philippines since 1991. Presently there are 3 Communities and 10 Sisters.



#### **Philippines 1: Grants for University Students.**

Objetive: That young students can go to university to finish their studies, and that they can improve their situation, their knowledge, and their development, and that they can contribute to the development of the country.

Place where the Project is carried out: Bagong Silang. Manila. Number of beneficiaries: 22 students.

Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €10,000

#### Philippines 2: Grants for University Students.

Objetive: To attend to malnourished children from their conception, to help reduce mortality so that their subsequent development is satisfactory, and to accompany families and pregnant mothers. Project location: Bagong Silang. Manila.

Number of beneficiaries: 250 children, 200 mothers and 50 pregnant women

Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €3.000

#### Philippines 3: MANNA (Food programme).

Objetive: To serve the most impoverished population of Bagong Silang, providing one meal a day, rich in nutrients in order to prevent disease and malnutrition in children between 2 and 6 years old. Project location: Bagong Silang. Manila. Number of beneficiaries: 740 children. Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €3,000

#### Philippines 4: People with different abilities.

Objective: To attend to a discriminated group, and without any attention from the government because of ignorance and overpopulation. To stimulate socialization and integral learning. Place where the Project is carried out: Bagong Silang Number of beneficiaries: 65 people. Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €5,000

#### INDIA

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been in India since 1987.There are 2 Communities and 9 Sisters.

#### India 1: Empowerment of women and children.

Objetive: To provide a peaceful space for studies, giving importance to the education of poor children, and to give special attention to weak students, so that they can improve results in their studies. Project location: Calcutta. India. Number of beneficiaries: 27 children. Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €2.000



### **MOZAMBIQUE**

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been in Mozambique since 1995. There are 2 Communities and 9 Sisters.



## PERÚ

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts has been present in Peru since 1848. There are 6 Communities a nd 34 Sisters.



#### India 2: Human and Christian Formation for Young people.

Objective: To offer a safe and familiar place for young women and girls in need, to accompany their process as women and students, and to provide them with a quality education for their future. Project location: Bhuvaneswar, Orissa State, Khurda District. India. Number of beneficiaries: 30 young people from rural areas. Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: €15.000

#### Mozambique: Lar Mamana Wa Kurula.

Objective: To welcome, support and educate orphan girls, victims of HIV and their mothers, with a comprehensive training that allows them to develop psychologically and professionally and enables them to face their future with autonomy. To provide them with a place to live, and to connect them with their families. Project location: Boane. Mozambique. Number of beneficiaries: 40 girls. Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: €8,000

#### Centre of formation and accompaniment "Escucha Betania".

Objective: To provide a space to experience listening, forgiveness, reconciliation, communication, mourning, and various social skills. Place where the Project is carried out: Arequipa. Peru. Number of beneficiaries: 400 people.

Amount contributed by the Aymer Foundation: €2,000
