

Project: Care of children and adults working on the street.


Objetive: Feeding and training in workshops for minors who work on the street, working on their motivation in training to improve their quality of life now and in the future.

Recipients: 150 adolescents, Young women and their trainers.



Proyect: Special education for persons who are deaf and dumb and a a psycho-pedagogical Project

Objetive: Enable students to achieve autonomy in the basic routines of cleanliness, study and daily life, in order to encourage their personal autonomy, offering appropriate training.

Ecuador

The Congregation has been here since 1862. At present there are 57 Sisters in 13 Communities



Project: Welcome and care for refugees.



Objetive: Care for people in situations of high risk and human mobility, so that they can reintegrate into the daily, social and economic life of the country.

Assisting displaced families or those who have returned to the country without means of subsistence.



Recipients: 80 households.

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 8.000 €




