

WITH THE HEART IN THE WORLD

Bolivia



The Congregation has been here since 1.883. At present there are 7 Sisters in 2 Communities.



Project: Care of children and adults working on the street.

Objective: Feeding and training in workshops for minors who work on the street, working on their motivation in training to improve their quality of life now and in the future.



Location: La Paz



Recipients: 60 children and adolescents and their families.



Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 10.000 €.



Congo



The Congregation has been here since 1969. At present there are 16 sisters in 4 Communities.

CONGO 1:



Proyect: Sponsorship, literacy and professional training for women (sewing).

Objetive: To contribute to the employment opportunities and personal development of young women who have had to abandon their studies due to the need to work or take care of the home.



Location: Kinshasa. Barrio Masina I.



Recipients: 150 adolescents, Young women and their trainers.



Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 2.500 €.



CONGO 2:



Project: Sacred Hearts Primary and Secondary School.

Objective: Objective: To ensure the care and schooling of pupils in order to prepare them for their future, offering them the possibility of continuing their education at university.



Location: Kinshasa. Barrio Masina I.



Recepients: 1.500 students



Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 65.000 €.



CONGO 3:



Project: Special education for persons who are deaf and dumb and a psycho-pedagogical Project

Objective: Enable students to achieve autonomy in the basic routines of cleanliness, study and daily life, in order to encourage their personal autonomy, offering appropriate training.





Location: Kinshasa. Barrio Masina I.



Recipients: 28 children jóvand Young peopoe with physical disabilities and training for their parents, 3 teachers (social educators).

Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 7.500 €.



CONGO 4:



Project: Kinesiterapia. Atención a las personas con discapacidad física.

Objetivo: To care for patients who do not have the means for rehabilitation, who live in a situation of precariousness and violence without the possibility of improving their rheumatic, traumatic, orthopaedic and neurological problems..



Location: Kinshasa. Comuna Masina I.



Recipients: 500 people, children, Young people and adults.



Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 12.000 €.

Ecuador

The Congregation has been here since 1862. At present there are 57 Sisters in 13 Communities.



Project: Welcome and care for refugees.



Objective: Care for people in situations of high risk and human mobility, so that they can reintegrate into the daily, social and economic life of the country.

Assisting displaced families or those who have returned to the country without means of subsistence.



Location: Barrio Las Casas de Quito.



Recipients: 80 households.



Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 8.000 €

Philippines



The Congregation has been here since 1991. At present there are 9 Sisters in 2 Communities.

PHILIPPINES 1:



Project: Becas para Universitarios.

Objective: To offer young people the possibility to attend university and complete their studies, to improve their situation and their knowledge, thus contributing to the development of the individual and the country.



Location: Bagong Silang. Manila.



Recipients: 27 students.



Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 5.000 €.

PHILIPPINES 2:




Project: Nutrition project: "Celebration of Life".



Objective: To care for malnourished children from pregnancy onwards, to help reduce the mortality rate, and to accompany families and pregnant mothers.



 Location: Bagong Silang. Manila.

 Recipients: 220 children, 180 mothers 50 pregnant women.

 Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 4.446 €.


FILIPINAS 3:

 **Project:** People with disabilities.

Objective: To attend to a discriminated group without any attention from the government due to ignorance and overpopulation. Encourage socialisation and integral learning



 Location: Bagong Silang. Manila.


 Recipients: 80 people

 Amount given to the Aymer Foundation: 7.063 €.

India



The Congregation has been there since 1987. At present there are 8 Sisters in 2 Communities.

 **Project:** Empowerment of women and children.

Objective: To provide adequate space for studies, encouraging the education of children without resources and with difficulties, so that they can improve their academic results..





Location: Calcuta.



Recipients: 30 young people in rural areas



Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 4.500 €.



Mexico



The Congregation has been here since 1986 At present there are 6 Sisters in 1 Community

Project: Welcome and care of migrants



Objective: Offer humanitarian aid to migrants in transit to the US so that they can continue their journey in better conditions for food, rest, sanitation, cleanliness, etc.



Local Colonization: Bojay. Atitalaquia.



Recipients: 14.600 persons.

Project: Lar Mamana Wa Kurula.



Objective: To welcome, support and educate by offering a comprehensive education to orphaned girls, victims themselves or their parents of HIV. To provide them with a home to live and grow up in, where they can develop psychosocially and professionally, enabling them to face their future with autonomy.



Location: Boane.



Recipients: 44 children.

Objective: To provide a space to experience listening, forgiveness, reconciliation, communication, grief and various social skills.






