# BOLIVIA

The Congregation has been here since 1.883. At present there are 7 Sisters in 2 Communities.



**Project:** Women's workshop

**Objective:** To provide training for women, a marginalised sector of society, so that they have the technical training to access sources of work which will boost their family's income.



**Location:** La Paz



**Beneficiaries:** 130 women.



**Amount given by the Aymer Fundacion:** 10.000 €.







# CONGO

The Congregation has been here since 1969. At present there are 17 sisters in 4 Communities.

## CONGO 1:



**Project:**, Sponsorship, literacy and professional training for women (sewing).

**Objective:** Contribute to the employment opportunities and personal development of young women who have had to drop out of school because of the need to work or take care of the house. Prevention of dependency and abuse. Improve teachers' salaries and thus enhance the quality of their work.



**Location:** Kinshasa Neighbourhood Masina I.



**Beneficiaries:** 100 adolescentes, Young and their teachers.



**Amount of money given by the Aymer Foundation** 10.000 €.



## CONGO 2:



**Project:** Psychopedagogical and health care for the deaf and dumb.

**Objective:** To offer appropriate training for deaf and mentally handicapped children. Promote their integration into society and facilitate their becoming autonomous. To provide them with appropriate materials for their development.



**Location:** Kinshasa. Neighbourhood

**Beneficiaries:** 500 people

**Amount given by the Aymer Foundation:** 7.500 €.



## CONGO 3:





**Projecto:** Sacred Hearts School (Primary and Secondary)

**Objective:** To ensure the care and schooling of pupils to prepare them for their future, offering them the possibility of being able to continue their education at university.

To form responsible people capable of standing up for their rights and for justice.

# PHILIPPINES



The Congregation has been here since 1991. At present there are 6 Sisters in 2 Communities.

## PHILIPPINES 1:



**Project:** Food for the elderly.

**Objective:** To create and maintain an open centre for senior citizens, where they can eat a nutritious lunch, receive regular medical care, proper hygiene, recreation, and can attend various workshops in a close family environment.





Location: Bagong Silang,

Beneficiaries: 100 people.



Amount given by the Aymer  
Foundation: 8.000 €.



## PHILIPPINES 2:



**Project:** Grants for university  
students.

**Objective:** To encourage students to go to university to finish their studies without interruption, and to improve their situation, their knowledge, and their advancement in order to contribute to the development of their families and the country.



Location: Bagong Silang, Manila.



Beneficiaries: 24 students.



Amount given by the Aymer Foundation: 5.000 €.





### PHILIPPINES 3:



**Project:** Celebration of life.

**Objective:** The care of malnourished children from the time of their gestation, to help reduce mortality, so that their later development is satisfactory.

Accompanying families and pregnant mothers.

Monthly coaching and visits to beneficiary families to monitor their progress.



**Location:** Bagong Silang. Manila.



**Beneficiaries:** 400 people.



**Amount of money given by the Aymer Foundation:** 5.000 €.

### PHILIPPINES 4:



**Project:** MANNA. Food Project.

**Objective:** To reduce hunger and malnutrition in the population in the early years of life by providing a daily nutrient-rich meal, monitoring weight and height to prevent disease, and stimulating them through creative activities.

**Location:** Bagong Silang. Manila.



**Beneficiaries:** 60 people.



**Amount given by the Aymer Foundation:** 3.000 €.





## PHILIPPINES 5:



**Project:** People with different capacities.

**Objective:** To care for a discriminated group, without any attention from the government, due to ignorance and overpopulation.

To stimulate socialisation and integral learning.

To encourage the socialisation of people who are hidden in their homes and rejected by society and sometimes by their families.



**Location:** Bagong Silang, Manila. 🌸

**Beneficiaries:** 80 people.



**Amount given by the Aymer Foundation:** 10.000 €.



# INDIA

The Congregation has been here since 1987. At present there are 12 Sisters in 2 Communities.



**Project:** Empowerment of Young women.

**Objective:** To provide a quality accommodation service so that young girls from the villages can continue their university studies and promote their human development.

Empowering young girls to gain knowledge about their rights and duties as citizens to avoid sexual harassment, violence, and injustice in society.



**Location:** Bhubaneswar. Odissa.



**Beneficiaries:** 37 young people in rural zones



**Amount given by the Aymer Foundation:** 8.000 €.



# MEXICO



The Congregation has been here since 1986. At the moment there are 6 Sisters in 1 Community.

**Project:** Welcome and care of migrants



To offer humanitarian aid to migrants in transit to the US so that they can continue their journey in better conditions for food, rest, sanitation, cleanliness, etc.

Beneficiaries: 6.000 people.

The Congregation has been here since 1995. At present there are 8 Sisters in 2 Communities.

## MOZAMBIQUE 1

**Project:** Study grants for children's centre pupils.



**Objective:** Enable children from 3 to 5 years of age without economic resources and in a situation of vulnerability to have access to education for one year, to improve, from an early age, their educational achievement in the years that follow.

## MOZAMBIQUE 2

**Project:** Upkeep of the Children's Centre building.



**Objective:** To conserve and improve the facilities of the children's centre, with the painting of rooms, pavilions, repair of the façade, for a better development of the activities..

## MOZAMBIQUE 3

**Project:** Lar Mamana Wa Kurula.



**Objective:** To welcome, support and educate by offering comprehensive training to orphaned girls, or their parents, who are victims of HIV. To provide them with a home to live and grow up in, where they can develop psychosocially and professionally so that they can face their future with autonomy.

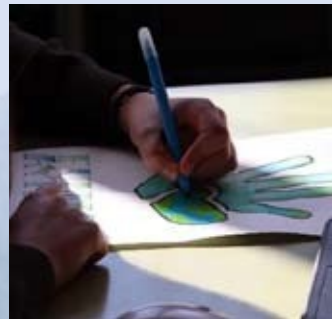

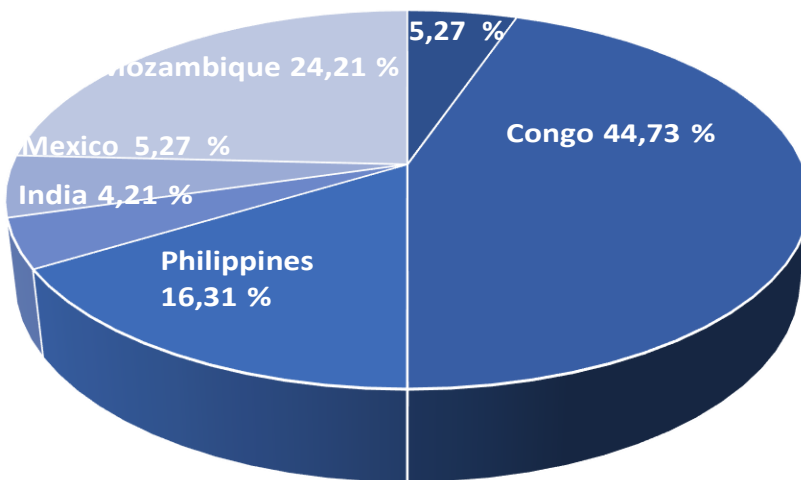
